8550 - COMPETITIVE FOOD SALES

The Food and Nutrition Services Department shall be the sole provider of food and beverage items sold in all schools until fifteen (15) minutes following the last lunch period, at which time other school organizations may begin to sell foods and beverage items in accordance with the Board's food service policy (Policy 8500) and guidelines (AG 8500 and AG 8500A) and with the Food Service Director and the Principal's approval. All food items and beverages sold to students that will be consumed on the school campus (any area of property under the jurisdiction of the school that is accessible to students during the school day) during the school day (the period from the midnight before, to thirty (30) minutes after the end of the official school day) shall comply with the USDA Dietary Guidelines for Americans and the USDA Smart Snacks in School nutrition standards.

Food and beverages sold during the school day outside the cafeteria may be operated on a "profit share" program with prior approval of the Director of the Food and Nutrition Services Department and the principal.
