Bike Helmet & Safety

Release and Waiver of Liability

Children's Hospital Medical Center of Akron, The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company and The Goodyear Foundation (Collectively referred to as "the Charitable Donors") have provided a bicycle safety helmet ("helmet"), safety training, bike safety check and safety information to me.

In exchange for the helmet and other good and valuable consideration, I hereby:

1. Acknowledge that there is an inherent risk of injury when participating in any physical activity including bicycling. I fully understand that bicycling may involve risk of serious injury or death, property damage, and economic losses. I HEREBY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS both known and unknown arising from bicycling and the use of the helmet.
2. Acknowledge that use of a helmet does not guarantee a child's safety while bicycling.
3. **UNDERSTAND THAT THE CHARITABLE DONORS DO NOT MAKE ANY WARRANTY REGARDING THE HELMET. THE CHARITABLE DONORS DO NOT WARRANT THE QUALITY OR FITNESS OF THE HELMET AND EXPRESSLY DISAVOW ANY IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.**
4. **RELEASE, INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD HARMLESS** the Charitable Donors, their employees and agents, from and against any and all losses, costs, claims, demands, cause of action, injury, damage and liability whatsoever, whether presently known or unknown and acknowledge that the Charitable Donors, their employees and agents are not responsible or liable in any way for any product defects in, or injuries resulting from the use of this helmet, safety training (potentially including a bike safety ride), bike safety check or safety information.
5. Understand I am responsible for fitting the helmet according to the manufacturer's instructions.

I HAVE READ THIS DOCUMENT, AND UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND SIGN VOLUNTARILY.

**2021 NEW FRANKLIN POLICE DEPARTMENT'S SAFETY CITY PROGRAM DETAIL
JUNE 1 THROUGH JUNE 4, 2021**

Safety City will start at **9:00 A.M. and end at 11:30 A.M.** You can drop your child off by 8:45 A.M., if necessary. For dismissal you can pull your vehicle to the sidewalk curb and we will bring your child out for you.

- **DAY 1 (TUESDAY - JUNE 1, 2021)**

**Bike Safety
Seatbelt Safety**

We will be teaching your child about proper bike safety and rules for riding on the roadway. Your child will be participating in riding big wheels through a miniature city safety course. We will also be discussing the current seatbelt laws referencing child seats and booster seats.

- **DAY 2 (WEDNESDAY - JUNE 2, 2021)**

**Gun Safety – Eddie the Eagle
Water Safety**

We will be teaching your child about what to do if they find a gun. We will not teach gun handling, nomenclature or gun use. We will also be learning water safety with the Ohio Division of Natural Resources.

- **DAY 3 (THURSDAY – JUNE 3, 2021)**

**Bus Safety – Practice Getting On and Off the Bus
Stranger Danger**

We will be teaching your child about the rules for riding on the bus. We will practice with a school bus from the Manchester Local Schools on the proper way of behaving, boarding and getting off the bus. We will be taking a short bus ride in the immediate area to practice getting on and off.

- **DAY 4 (FRIDAY – JUNE 4, 2021)**

**Fire Safety with the New Franklin Fire Department
Video and Puppet Show from Children's Hospital Burn Unit**

Along with the New Franklin Fire Department, we will teach your child proper fire safety. They will learn how to prevent fires and what to do in case of a fire. The children will also get a chance to play on and tour a fire truck. *Please have your child wear their bathing suit under their clothes this day and bring a towel and sunscreen!!!*
