Kindergarten Registration & Screening

For incoming Kindergarten students & families

May 6 at Nolley Elementary School

STUDENTS WILL:

Rotate through a series of stations/centers with Nolley Staff to complete the following:

- Hearing/Vision Screening
- Literacy Readiness
- Math Readiness
- Social Readiness

PARENTS WILL:

Complete the registration process on site, and turn in immunizations records:

- Meet with registrar and provide all necessary documents
- Meet with district RN
- Meet with a kindergarten teacher

To schedule your screening appointment, please call the Nolley School office at 330-882-4133.

Appointments will last approximately 1 hour.

All students must be 5 years old on or before September 30, of the year they are to begin school, in order for them to start kindergarten.

What is needed to register - A Nolley admission form may be completed on www.panthercountry.org (under Forms and Links), printed, and brought with you to save you from completing it in writing. Please bring the following required items to your registration/screening appointment:

- Two current proofs of Manchester Local residency of child and parent/guardian (utility bill, payroll check, mortgage/rental/bank statement, official government correspondence, voter registration, or insurance document)
- Birth Certificate (from the bureau of Vital Statistics)
- Immunization records
- Custody papers (entire court order allocating parental rights and responsibilities or other documents allocating custody or guardianship if the student is not living with birth parents)
- Parent/guardian's photo ID
- IEP/MFE (if applicable)
